

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR CLIENTS

THESE ARE PART OF THE TERMS OF USE OF OUR WEBSITE AND CLARIFY RELATIONSHIPS ON OUR WEBSITE

- A. A client can never violate the intellectual property right of another person or ask somebody else to violate it. Everything on the FUTURE BAKERS website is owned by the person who originally created it until it is bought and paid for. At that point, the intellectual property of the product is transferred to the CLIENT, and clients can use the product, part of it or not use the product at all as it suits their project. Client can also resell the project.
- B. A client has to pay FUTURE BAKERS the amount agreed upon between Future Bakers and the Client (a separate agreement from the Terms of Use) before Future Bakers puts the Client's Brief on the website.
- C. A client should review all the entries to the project carefully. If the Client needs help from Future Bakers in reading and/or analyzing the entries, please let us know in your Brief.
- D. Never ask a Baker to use an idea or concept from a different Baker. Each idea of a Baker should be protected and respected.
- E. Please, try to select your favorite idea/solution in a timely manner.
- F. If you do not choose any of the ideas presented, you still have to pay Future Bakers for site usage and idea generation. However, you are not required to pay any reward you do not choose any of the ideas presented.
- G. Please, make sure that your behavior on the website is courteous and respectful. We do not accept foul language or demeaning behavior.
- H. A client is not allowed to directly interact with one of the creators of Future Bakers or try to hire them without Future Bakers written permission, unless the Baker is part of the group working on the client's project and not until Future Bakers has received payment from that Client.
